### **Report of the Functioning of Autonomous College 2019-20**

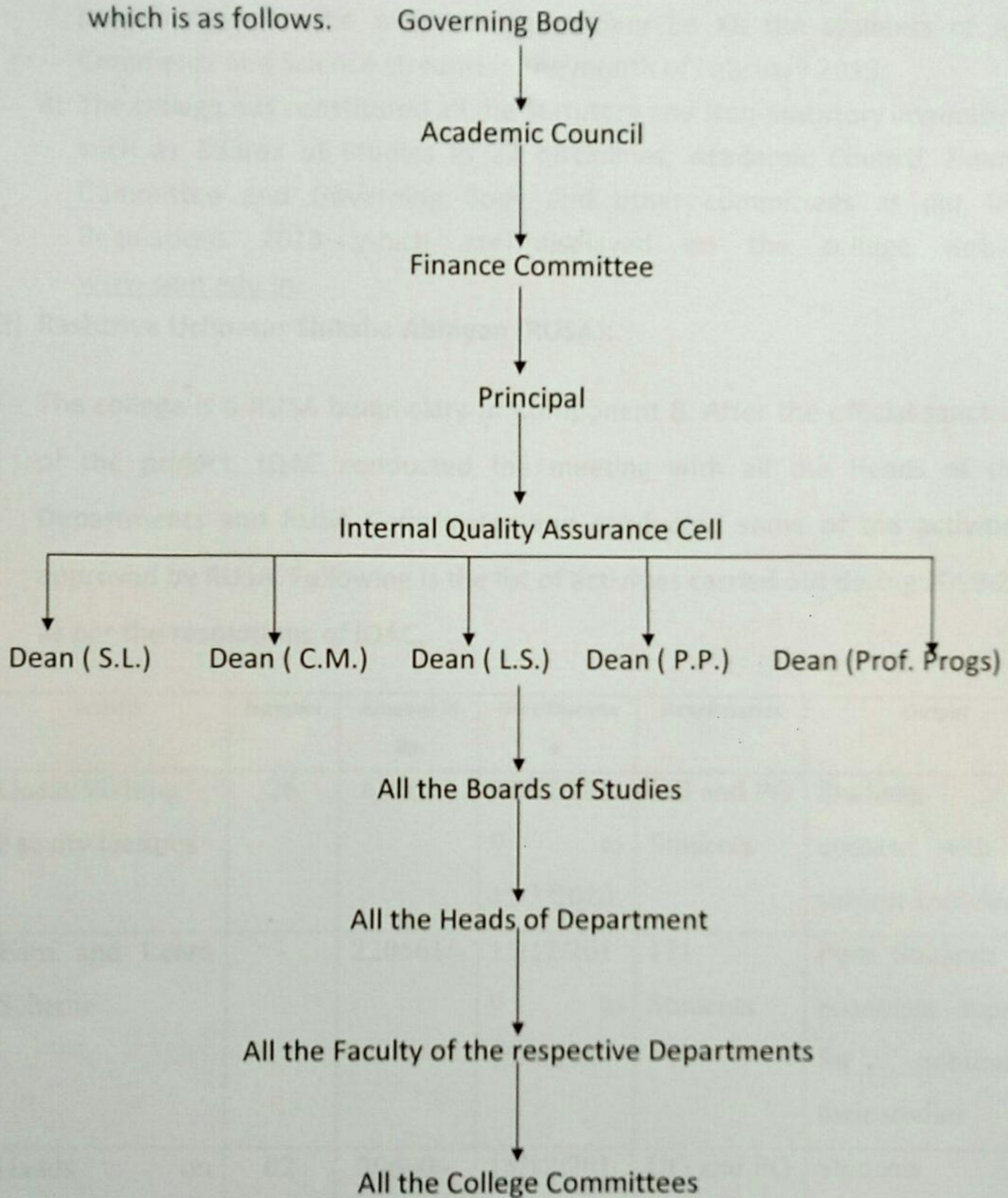
It is a pleasure for me to present the report of the functioning of an Autonomous college from June 2019 to the UGC- WRO, Pune.

First of all, I extend my sense of thankfulness towards UGC, New Delhi for conferring upon us an autonomous status to our college from June 2019 for the period of ten years. As per the directives issued by UGC, New Delhi, Govt. of Maharashtra and Shivaji University, Kolhapur, the college has initiated the functioning of an autonomous college from June 2019.

Following are the activities we have carried out during the academic year 2019-20.

- 1) The college received the Fresh Autonomous status from UGC through its letter No.F22-1/2017 (AC) dated 28 Dec.2018.
- 2) It has also received the Conferment of Fresh Autonomous status from Shivaji University, Kolhapur through its letter No.SU/Affi./T-2/Autonomy/1907 dtd. 20/2/2019.
- 3) In purview of the autonomous status, the college has defined policies for curricula revision, redefining teaching methodologies, Evaluation pattern and the preparation of study material and Question Bank.
- 4) The college has adopted School concept and channelized 4 schools respective to streams and carried out its academic, research and extension activities.

5) The administrative structure of the Autonomous college has been prepared which is as follows.



6) IQAC has organized 3 Orientation Programmes for Faculty and Administrative staff in the months of October and November 2018.

7) The IQAC coordinator Dr. G.B. Kalyanshetti has conducted 3 orientation programmes for the would-be beneficiary i.e XII the students of Arts Commerce and Science streams in the month of February 2019.

8) The college has constituted all the Statutory and Non-Statutory committees such as Boards of Studies in 22 disciplines, Academic Council, Finance Committee and Governing Body and other committees as per UGC Regulations 2018 which are displayed on the college website [www.sgm.edu.in](http://www.sgm.edu.in).

9) **Rashtriya Uchhatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA):**

The college is a RUSA beneficiary of Component 8. After the official sanction of the project, IQAC conducted the meeting with all the Heads of the Departments and RUSA Coordinator and conducted some of the activities approved by RUSA. 10) **UGC- STRIDE SCHEME:**

The college through IQAC has received the research proposals from the faculty for the UGC- STRIDE 2019-20. The IQAC has conducted a Screening of the research proposals in presence of IQAC Chairperson Prin. Dr. M.M. Rajmane, IQAC Coordinator Dr. G.B. Kalyanshetti, Coordinator of Research Committee Dr. M.S.Patil and RUSA Coordinator Dr. U.B. More and approved

15 research proposals to be submitted to UGC. Out of which 1 Major research proposals in the category of College as a whole, 6 from Science and 7 from Arts streams. UGC has shortlisted 1 Major proposal of Dr. S.V. Mahamuni from Chemistry Department for UGC- STRIDE.

The college has prepared the Budget for 2019-20 and the same is discussed and rectified in the presence of Shri. V.T. Patil, Finance Officer, Shivaji University, Kolhapur in the Finance Committee meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2019 and the approved Budget is submitted to UGC-WRO, PUNE. The college also has submitted Utilization in the given format to UGC\_WRO, Pune.

- 11) The meetings of all the statutory bodies such as Boards of Studies, Finance Committee, Academic Council, Governing Body and Board of Exams have been organized and the proceedings of the same are displayed on the college website [www.sgm.edu.in](http://www.sgm.edu.in).
- 12) There are 22 Boards of Studies that have conducted the meetings of Sub-Committee and Boards of Studies in which the curricula and Evaluation pattern for the first year UG& PG classes have been revised following a systematic process.
- 13) The college has adopted 60 Marks (Semester End Exam) and 40 Marks (Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation) pattern.
- 14) The Examination committee has defined various measures of evaluation such as Online MCQ, Assignment, test, oral etc from which the department has a freedom to opt 4 for 40 Marks CCE.
- 15) The college has adopted Choice Based Credit system for the first year UG and PG programmes which will sustain for a year and the next two years respectively.
- 16) 22 Departments have organized Workshops on Revised Curricula in the months of May and June 2019.

- 17) The First meetings of the Statutory Bodies such as Governing Body, Academic Council, and Finance Committee have been organized and the proceedings of the same are displayed on the college website
- 18) The college has successfully conducted Entrance Exam for the admissions to the P.G. in 9 Science Subjects at 8 Centres in the month of May and June.
- 19) The First Semester end Examination of the first year U.G. & P.G. programmes was conducted between 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2019 and 24<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 and the Results of the same are declared online.
- 20) The college has ETH Software for Admission through which all the admissions for first year U.G. & P.G. Classes were given online.
- 21) The 24 Dept. have organised Guest lecturers once a month.
- 22) The college has adopted a Dual Programme under Autonomy for the first year U.G. & P.G. Classes. The students of each discipline have opted One Skill Based Programme from the list and the said programme would continue as Certificate at first year, Diploma at second and Advanced Diploma at the third year respectively. The said programme is adopted to increase students' employability.
- 23) For effective teaching, the college has purchased 1 Smart Board, 1 Video Conferencing Unit, 10 LCDs, 15 Scanner with Printer and 150 computers and Laptops.
- 24) The 70 % of its faculty engaged their classes through ICT resources. The soft copy of e resources is maintained in the Library.
- 25) The college has installed Lecture Capturing System (LCS) through which 60 % faculty members have captured their lectures and are uploaded on the YouTube.
- 26) The college has organized 2 International Conferences in Marathi & Social Sciences respectively and a National seminar in Life Sciences.
- 27) The college through IQAC has constituted the **The External Peer Team** for the Review of the performance of the college as an Autonomous college through its appointment letters No 1928/19-20 dated 6-12-2019. The team comprised of Dr. C.J. Khilare, Principal, (Chairman), Balwant College, Vita, Dr. Dr.S.B.Kengar,(

Member), Principal, Yashwantrao Chavan College of Science, Karad and Dr. G.V.Mali, ( Member), IQAC Coordinator, Smt. Bayabai Shripatrao Kadam Kanya mahavidyalay, Kadegaon. The committee visited the college on 16th December 2019 to review the performance of the college made so far as an Autonomous college. They inspected related documents in the context of autonomy between 11.00 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on the campus and submitted the report to IQAC, the copy of which is sent to UGC-WRO, Pune.
