Minutes of the 1st Meeting of Academic Council held on 31st Jan. 2023

Welcome and Introduction

Prof. (Dr.) A. K. Patil, Member Secretary & Coordinator, Autonomous College welcomed Hon'ble members to the first meeting of Academic Council and he thanked them for attending the meeting. He welcomed them in the pretext of the completion of the First cycle and beginning of second cycle of Academic Autonomy in August 2022. The meeting started at 11.35 a.m.

The team reached in Mar Ivanios College on 10:00 am and discussed many issues regarding autonomy with the Principal and his faculty members such as syllabus structure, examination pattern, and handling of confidential documents, BoS functioning, Academic Council and Governing Body,teaching methodology, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities etc. conducted by the college. The Scott Christen College, Nagarcoil in Tamil Nadu has visited by the team in afternoon session and made fruitful academic discussion. On second day team members visited Fathima Mata National College, Kollam in morning session and made interaction with the Principal and students also. The CMS College is also visited by the team in afternoon session. This college was established in 1817 and managed by Christen Missionary. According to the Principal, this is first western college in India. Total area of the college was 48 acres which includes 8 acre forest with QR coded trees. On the third day (11.01.2023) the team was visited Rajagiri College, Ernakulum. This college is ranked second as Social Work College in India with 3.83 CGPA by NAAC in fourth cycle. The team visited Maharaja College Cochin in afternoon. There were 60 departments working under various disciplines in the college. The team rigorously observed the examination pattern, construction of Board of Studies,
