Minutes of the 1st Meeting of Academic Council (2020-21) held on 15th October 2020

Welcome and Introduction

Dr. S.R. Sawant, Secretary, AC, welcomed Hon'ble members to the First online meeting of Academic Council for 2020-21 and he thanked them for attending the meeting virtually. The meeting started at 11.00 a.m.

2.1. Confirmation of the Minutes of the First Meeting

Dr. G.B. Kalyanshetti read the proceedings of the Second meeting of Academic Council held on 19th June item wise. He elaborated on the completion of all the activities resolved in the meeting and asked members to kindly approve it. Hon'ble members approved the proceedings by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

1.2 To Approve the Curricula, Course Structure, Fees, eligibility, syllabus, of the Second year U.G. and P.G. Programmes.

The matter of the approval of the curricula, course structure, fees, eligibility of the second year UG and PG programmes for the academic year 2020-21 was discussed in the meeting. The IQAC Coordinator acquainted the house with the aforesaid elaborating various measures undertaken such as reception of the feedback from the stakeholders, suggestions from the Sub Committee of respective Boards of Studies and their compliances in the Boards of Studies meetings. And the Academic Council unanimously approved revised curricula for the following .

Arts –B.A.-II (Languages & Social Sciences) ,M.A.-II (Languages and Social Sciences)

Commerce - B.Com.-II,M.Com.-II

Science -B.Sc.-II, M.Sc.-II

Professional Courses – B.Com.I.T.-II ,M.Com.I.T.-II,B.C.A-II ,B.Sc. Computer Science (Entire)-II, Bio.Tech.-II (Entire)

The coordinator requested the house to approve these activities.

All the members unanimously approved it by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

1.3 To approve the rules for Admissions from other Autonomous, other colleges from the same university and other universities.

The issue of the students' admissions from other Autonomous, colleges and Universities was considered in the meeting and The Coordinator of Autonomous college told the house that the rules have been framed regarding the same in consonance to the norms of the UGC. The Council has approved the following rules.

1. Student who has passed or has A.T.K.T. at the First year U.G & P.G. is eligible to take admission for the second year U.G. & P.G. classes
2. In case of a student who has not cleared all subjects of the first year U.G. & P.G. classes and has obtained A.T.K.T. , it is his/her responsibility to clear all subjects of previous exam from the respective University.
3. College will not be responsible for student's previous examinations results or any such matter related to the first year U.G. & P.G. classes.
4. The merit list, Grade system, CGPA for such students will be calculated from the year of admission taken in SGM College, Karad

5. Admission will be given strictly on merit basis.
6. In case of such student, his/her performance of only II & III will be considered while declaring his/her result at the last year and such student, if passed the previous examination, Result will be declared only as Pass and no class (Distinction, First, Second etc) will be awarded to him/her.

The same is approved and resolved.

1.4 To approve the rules for Equivalence

Dr. Girish Kalyanshetti brought to the notice of the house the issue of Equivalence of the curricula taking into account the admissions of students from other colleges and universities and the Council unanimously approved the following rule.

If the change in the syllabus of the First year of U.G. & P.G. classes of the previous college/ University of the student and the syllabi of the respective classes of SGM College, Karad is less than 30% , then the Equivalence is granted. Status: The Meetings of all the Boards of Studies have been held. During these meetings, the syllabi of the first year of UG & PG of various Universities(Kolhapur, Pune, Aurangabad etc) have been compared with that of the Syllabi of SGM College, Karad

After a careful study, if it is observed that no any subject has more than 30% change in syllabi, Only then the Two syllabi will be considered as Equivalent. Further he said that the same was approved by the members of BoSs, SGM College, Karad.

The same is approved and resolved.

1.5 To approve the Examination question paper pattern for the revised curricula of UG & PG programmes

The Coordinator told the house that the college has initiated Examination Reforms under Autonomy and has adopted 60 SEE and 40 CCE Examination pattern. He told the house that the pattern has been successfully implemented during 2019-20. However, he said, as per the guidelines of Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, Satara , the Question paper pattern for Second year UG programme in Arts has been reframed in terms of 60 Marks SEE and 40 marks CCE having 3 instead of 4 Internal Evaluation measures. The Council unanimously approved the revised Question paper

pattern for II year UG in Arts as well as CCE having 3 evaluation measures instead of 4.

The same is approved and resolved.

1.6 To approve the names of paper setters, moderators, examiners recommended by 26 Boards of Studies for first year UG and PG as well as Dual Programme

The names of paper setters, moderators, examiners recommended by 24 Boards of Studies were considered. The Secretary told the house that the paper setters for the Examinations under Autonomy are from outside the district to bring in efficiency and transparency in the examination.

The same is approved and resolved.

1.7. To approve the teaching methodologies

The Coordinator told the house that the college has exclusively adopted Online teaching in the wake of global pandemic of COVID 19 and has installed 3 studios through which more than 500 lectures of the faculty members have been recorded and the same is uploaded on the college website on the tab Knowledge Bank. Further he said, the faculty members also use e resources such as Zoom, Webex, Google classroom, Google forms etc and daily 3 to 4 lecture are delivered online as per timetable.

1.8. To discuss the Curricula, Course Structure, Fees, eligibility, syllabus, of the Second year Diploma under Dual Programme

The matter of the approval of the curricula, course structure, fees, eligibility of the Diploma under Dual Programme for the academic year 2020-21 has been taken in the meeting and is discussed and approved. However, the IQAC Coordinator told the house that due to the advent of COVID 19, taking into account the students' safety, this matter of introducing the Diploma for the second year UG programmes is kept as status quo now and the decision regarding that, the Chairperson said, will be taken soon.

The coordinator requested the house to approve these activities.

All the members unanimously approved it by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

1.9 To approve the Academic Calendar for 2020-21

The Coordinator told the house that the IQAC has prepared the Academic Calendar of the college for the year 2020-21 signalling all the academic, curricular, extracurricular, exam related activities. He asked all the members to approve of it.

All the members unanimously approved it by raising their hands.

1.10. To approve the AQAR for 2019-20

Dr. G.B. Kalyanshetti, IQAC Coordinator told the members that the AQAR for 2019-20 is prepared by submitting the data online on NAAC portal and intends to submit by 25th October 2020. Further he said that NAAC has extended the time line for the submission of pending AQARs by 31st May 2021. The Chairperson told the house that the AQAR for 2019-20 will be submitted to NAAC in the last week of March 2021 after complying with all the metrics of Criteria 2 and 5.

The House unanimously approved the decision regarding the submission of AQAR for 2019-20.

1.11. Any Other Issues:

Reflections by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor's Nominees:

After the approval of the agenda, Hon'ble Dr. G.J. Fagare addressed the house online and he thanked the college for giving him an opportunity to work in this Academic Council. He said that he was very much impressed by the academic work being carried by the college on the campus. He also outlined the importance of Autonomy and asked the house to maintain the same zeal and enthusiasm towards pursuit of quality by undertaking more and more student-centric activities.

Hon'ble Y.B. Gonde appreciated the work being carried by the college and congratulated the college on conducting online webinars during COVID 19 outbreak. He said that he was very much impressed by the work of installation of 3 studios of Lecture Capturing, 74 NIRF ranking, Dual programme and opined that the college will definitely avail DST-FIST and STAR college status. He also felt happy about the work of IQAC in preparing AQAR, conducting activities under Autonomy. He elaborated that the examination pattern of 60+40 adopted by the college as per directives of the Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, which he said, is really relevant. He expressed his sense of

thankfulness towards the Chair and Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Shivaji University for giving him an opportunity to work in the Academic Council of this college.

Dr. M.M. Rajmane, in his address, congratulated the Autonomous College Coordinator Dr. G.B. Kalyanshetti for a nice presentation of the agenda. And thanked the Vice-Chancellor's Nominees, Chairpersons of BoSs and the invited faculty for participating in the discussion in the meeting. He further told the members that the college has integrated curricula. Further he elaborated on various activities planned for 2020-21 and opined that the college will sustain its momentum in the quest of quality in all realms of academic and research pursuits.
