

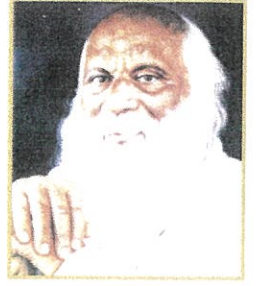

Minutes of the 2nd Meeting of Academic Council (2020-21) held on 8th April 2021 at 11.00 a.m.

Welcome and Introduction:

Dr. S.R. Sawant, Member Secretary, Academic Council, welcomed Hon'ble members to the Second online meeting of Academic Council for 2020-21 and thanked them for attending the meeting virtually. The meeting started at 11.00 a.m.

1.1. Confirmation of the Minutes of the First Meeting

Autonomous college Coordinator Dr. G.B. Kalyanshetti read the proceedings of the First meeting of Academic Council held on 15th October item wise. He elaborated on the Confirmation of the Minutes of the First Meeting , Approval of the Curricula, Course Structure, Fees, eligibility, syllabus, of the Second year U.G. and P.G. Programmes : Arts –B.A.-II (Languages & Social Sciences) ,M.A.-II (Languages and Social Sciences), Commerce - B.Com.-II, M.Com.-II , Science -B.Sc.-II, M.Sc.-II, Professional Courses – B.Com.I.T.-II ,M.Com.I.T.-II,B.C.A-I , B.Sc. Computer Science (Entire)-II, Bio.Tech.-II (Entire) , approval of the rules for Admissions from other Autonomous, other colleges from the same university and other universities approval of the Examination question paper pattern for the revised curricula of UG & PG programmes, the names of paper setters, moderators, examiners recommended by 26 Boards of Studies for first year UG and PG as well as Dual Programme, teaching methodologies and rule for equivalence.

He requested the members to kindly approve of it.

Hon'ble members approved the proceedings by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

2.2 Inclusion to AC: Prof. S.S. Mahajan, Hon'ble Vice- Chancellor's Nominee

The Autonomous college coordinator put forward the issue of the inclusion of Prof. Dr. S.S. Mahajan , Prof & Head, Department of Commerce & Management, Shivaji University, Kolhapur since the earlier Hon'ble V.C. Nominee Dr. G.J. Fagare has taken over the responsibilities as the Associate Professor. He told the house that the Shivaji University through its letter No.SU/Affi./T3/340 dated 12 Jan 2021 has nominated Prof. Dr. S.S. Mahajan as Hon'ble VC Nominee in place of Dr. G.J. Fagare.

The Coordinator welcomed him and opined that the scholarship and expertise of Dr. S.S. Mahajan will help the college in enhancing the academic standard of the college.

He requested the members to approve of the inclusion of Dr. S.S. Mahajan to the Academic Council of the college.

Hon'ble members approved the proceedings by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

2.3. To approve of the programmes conducted under Autonomy

The Coordinator presented before the house the programmes conducted under Autonomy during the year and specified that the college has conducted 2 meetings of

Subcommittees and Boards of studies in 24 disciplines regarding the revision of curricula for the Third year UG and Advanced Diploma under Dual Programme, Conducted 2 meetings of Finance Committee, 2 meetings of Academic Council , 2 meetings of Governing Body and Conducted several meetings of Board of Examinations and further told the house that the minutes of all these meetings have been uploaded on the college website. Further, he said that the college has organised Entrance Examination for M.Sc. Part I at 4 centres in 3 districts in Sept./ Oct. 2020 and has Revised Examination Pattern and adopted SEE and CCE 60+40 pattern. Taking into account the pandemic situation, the college has delivered Online classes from July 2020 till date . He further elaborated that the college has installed Lecture Capturing System through which more than 600 captured lectures and the same are uploaded on the respective department channel. IQAC has conducted 4 meetings of IQAC and minutes of the same are uploaded on college website. He requested the members to approve of the activities conducted under Autonomy during the reporting year.

Hon'ble members approved the proceedings by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

2.4 To approve of the Curricula, Course Structure, Fees, eligibility, syllabus, of the Third year U.G. Programmes in Arts, Commerce and Science disciplines.

The matter of the approval of the curricula, course structure, fees, eligibility of the Third year UG programmes for the academic year 2021-22 was discussed in the meeting. The IQAC Coordinator acquainted the house with the aforesaid elaborating various measures undertaken such as reception of the feedback from the stakeholders, suggestions from the Sub Committee of respective Boards of Studies and their compliances in the Boards of Studies meetings. And the Academic Council unanimously approved revised curricula for the following .

Arts –B.A.-III(Languages & Social Sciences)

Commerce - B.Com.-II

Science -B.Sc.-II, M.Sc.-II

Professional Courses – B.Com.I.T.-III, B.C.A-III , B.Sc.III, B.Sc.III Computer Science (Entire)-Bio.Tech.-III (Entire)

The Coordinator requested the house to approve of these activities.

All the members unanimously approved of it by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

2.5.To approve of the activities under UGC- PARAMARSHA scheme

The coordinator told the house that the college has been sanctioned UGC PARAMARSHA scheme 2019-20 and has been effectively implemented for 9 mentee colleges from the vicinity. He further told the house that Action plan was prepared for the effective implementation and as per it, the IQAC has conducted 8 National level Activities carried till 15th March 2020 addressing NAAC issues. During this year, due to COVID pandemic, the college could not sustain the activities, however, it has organized A 5 day Workshop on Agro business Opportunities in Biosciences in collaboration with Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Rethare from 1st Feb to 5 Feb 2021. IQAC has also conducted Online meeting with the IQAC members and other Faculty members using zoom platform on 22nd April 2020. The coordinator further told the house that IQAC has conducted Online Webinar on Smart Tools for Teaching and Research using Zoom platform on 24th April 2020 in collaboration with Keshavrao Pawar Library, SGM college Karad. Shri.Arjun Jadhav from Mumbai was the Key speaker. IQAC has extended guidance to G.I. Bagewadi Arts, Science & Commerce, Nipani, Karnataka, to D.K. T. E. college of Textile Engineering, Ichalkaranji and to Vivekanand College, Kolhapur. He further told the house that IQAC has organized Online meeting with the Principals and IQAC Coordinators of Mentee colleges using Zoom platform. Dr. Pramod Pabrikar from RUSA, Mumbai and Dr. Mohan Rajmane were the Guest Speakers at the Online Webinar conducted on 9th May 2020 during COVID 19 Lockdown period.

The Coordinator requested the house to approve of these activities.

All the members unanimously approved of it by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

2.6 To approve of the Curricula, Course Structure, Fees, eligibility, syllabus, of the Advanced Diploma Programmes in Arts, Commerce and Science disciplines under Dual Programme.

The matter of the approval of the curricula, course structure, fees, eligibility of the Advanced Diploma programmes in Arts, Commerce and science disciplines for the academic year 2021-22 was discussed in the meeting. The IQAC Coordinator acquainted the house with the aforesaid elaborating various measures undertaken such as reception of the feedback from the stakeholders, suggestions from the Sub Committee of respective Boards of Studies and their compliances in the Boards of Studies meetings. And the Academic Council unanimously approved revised curricula for the following .

Arts –B.A.-III (Languages & Social Sciences)

Commerce - B.Com.-III

Science -B.Sc.-III, M.Sc.-III

Professional Courses – B.Com.I.T.-III,B.C.A-III ,B.Sc.III, B.Sc.III Computer Science (Entire)- Bio.Tech.-III (Entire)

The Coordinator requested the house to approve of these activities.

All the members unanimously approved of it by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

2.7 To approve of the activities conducted under Board of Examinations.

The coordinator put forward the issue of the activities conducted under Board of Examinations & Evaluation. He said that the Board has been functional adhering to the rules and regulations of Shivaji University, Kolhapur. He told the house that the Board has Conducted meetings of Board of Examinations, organized Entrance Examination for M.Sc. Part I at 4 centres in 3 districts in Sept./ Oct. 2020. He further asserted that the college has undertaken curtailment of Curricula of SEM 1 & 3 of UG & PG programmes as well as Curtailment of curricula for UG.Programmes: Sem V as per Shivaji University Guidelines .

He further asserted that the Board has Revised Examination pattern and adopted SEE and CCE 60+40 pattern and requested the house to seek approval to the Curtailment of Internal Evaluation measures under CCE: 3 Modules from 4 for UG& PG classes (Arts Faculty).

The coordinator told the house that a new software has been purchased from KBP College of Engineering, Satara to help the Board in Conduct of examinations.

He also stressed that the Board has conducted SEE and CCE for SEM 1 & 3 of UG & SEM 1 of PG programmes as well as conducted Exams for Repeaters of SEM 1 of UG & PG programmes (2019-20) Dec 2020

The Coordinator requested the house to approve of these activities.

All the members unanimously approved of it by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

2.8 To approve of the names of paper setters, moderators, examiners recommended by 26 Boards of Studies for first year UG and PG as well as Dual Programme

The Coordinator told the house that all the 24 Boards of Studies in their respective subjects have conducted meetings of subcommittee and Boards of Studies and approved the lists of Paper setters, moderators and examiners. He displayed the lists on the screen for the kind perusal of the members.

The Coordinator requested the house to approve of these activities.

All the members unanimously approved of it by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

2.9. To approve of the policy of Question paper setting, printing of the same.

The Coordinator brought forward the issue of the policy of the Question paper setting and the printing of the same and presented before the house the following policy.

In the wake of COVID 19, Online Examination has been the pertinent issue and through meetings of Board of Examinations & Evaluation and the resolutions have been passed as under:

Semester End Exam will be of 60 marks.

1. Multiple Choice Type Question paper in Excel format to be set.
2. Question Bank of 100-125 questions is to be prepared and be circulated to students.
3. 30 questions are to be set, out of which 25 are to be attempted.
4. Each question carries 2 marks.
5. Marks secured out of 50 will be converted into 60 (UG).
6. Practical examination of SEM 1 & 3 Science & Professional programmes carried offline.
7. Marks under CCE shall be filled in on the portal by the respective teacher through Head's login.

The Coordinator requested the house to approve of these activities.

All the members unanimously approved of it by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

2.10. To approve of the Plan of Action for 2021-22

The Coordinator told the house that IQAC in consultation with the Principal, has prepared the plan of Action for 2021-2022. He told the members that the college intends to start a programme of B.Com. in Bank Management, B.Sc Agriculture programme under B.Voc., Industrial Management as specialisation at B.Com. Part III and to start additional Divisions for M.Sc. Statistics, Microbiology, Organic Chemistry, Analytical Chemistry and the college also intends to start a Certificate Course in Yoga Therapy and Meditation.

The Coordinator requested the house to approve of these activities.

All the members unanimously approved of it by raising their hands.

The same is approved and resolved.

2.11. To approve of the AQAR for 2019-20

Dr. G.B. Kalyanshetti, IQAC Coordinator told the members that the AQAR for 2019-20 is prepared by submitting the data online on NAAC portal and intends to submit by the last week of April 2021. Further he said that NAAC has extended the time line for
