## <u>A Report</u>

I am happy to present the report of a workshop on Library As a learning resource & IT Infrastructure held on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2023 in A2-18. The workshop was chaired by Dr. Mohan Rajmane, Principal, S.G.M. College, Karad.

The Inaugural function of the workshop started at 10.00 am with the words of welcome by Dr. S.M. Jadhav. In his welcome speech, he asserted that the college is a NAAC designated mentor college and a UGC PARAMARSHA beneficiary. The college has been empowering 10 mentee colleges in all aspects of NAAC. He said that the college under IQAC has organized 22 activities for mentee colleges from Dec 2019 till date which include National level seminars, workshops, Guest lectures at the respective places of mentee colleges. He asserted that these activities have been organized on Sundays to ensure the larger participation of all the faculty of mentee colleges. He said that under RUSA- NAAC Mentoring activities, the IQAC proposed to organize 6 workshops on various systems & procedures as prescribed by NAAC. Further he said that today's event is one of these activities. He welcomed the Chair, the mentors and all the faculty of mentee colleges.

The First session on library as A learning resource started at 10.25 am with an introduction of the mentor Mr. M.N. Gaikwad, Librarian by Mr. Dhanaji Khot. The Mentor delivered his talks on Library System, services and elaborated on the importance of library, resources, need and rationale of the same.

In the Second session, he highlighted on the recent developments in the field due to availability of Digital means, automation, e-resources, access to web resources. The session came to an end by vote of thanks delivered by Shri. Dixit.

The Third session was started at 2.30 p.m. with the words of welcome & introduction by Shri. S.A. Patil, Vice Principal.
