Proposal of Congratulations to the CDC, Principal, IQAC and the faculty:

Proposed by: Mrs. S.S. Mahajan

Proposal: She put forward the proposal of the congratulations to the CDC, Principal, Coordinator and the faculty for attaining the 'Empowered Autonomous status' from the Shivaji University Kolhapur. 1.1 Confirmation of the proceedings of the last Meeting:

1.2 NAAC Revised Accreditation Process

Proposed by: Prof. Dr. G. B. Kalyanshetti

Proposal: The college was assessed and accredited by NAAC in April 2027 and awarded the college A+ grade with 3.63 CGPA for the third cycle. Due to Autonomous status, the college has been given the validity extension of 2 years i.e. 31st Dec. 2024.

Technical Information : He told the house that NAAC has initiated Reforms from **Jan.2024**. It has made an Important Announcement issued on 29th June 2024. According to it, our college is eligible for the fourth cycle Assessment & Accreditation process from 1st July 2024 onwards. As per the NAAC announcement, the college is eligible for the 4th cycle A&A in a new methodology wherein there are 2 stages in Accreditation process namely Binary Accreditation and Maturity Based Graded Levels. He told the house that NAAC is launching its respective manual in September 2024.

Guidelines given: Hon. Adv. Ravindra Pawar asked the Coordinator to devise the plan and sustain the work according to the new methodology. Hon. Principal. Dr. M.M. Rajmane directed the Coordinator to continue the A&A preparation as per the revised methodology.

IQAC views: He even told the house that the cell has prepared a action plan for the same and is working according to a new methodology based on the guidelines issued through the NAAC Workshop on Revised Methodology held on 19th March 2024.

1.3. Review of Admissions 2024-25

Proposed by : Dr. A. N. Mulik

Proposal: He presented the next issue of the Admissions done till date in the pretext of NEP 2020 (3.0) for the reporting year.

Technical Information: He further told the house that the year 2024-25 is the NEP 2020 implementation year in all the autonomous colleges in Maharashtra. He told the house that as

1.6 Preparation of AQAR 2023-24

Proposed by: Prof. Dr. G.B. Kalyanshetti

Proposal: He asserted that under the guidance of the CDC, Chairperson of IQAC Prin. Dr. Rajmane , the IQAC has been functioning quite effectively to sustain quality culture in all realms of academic endeavors. He told the house that all the AQARs of the previous years have been successfully submitted and got approved by NAAC, Bangalore.

IQAC views: Regarding the AQAR of the previous year i.e. 2023-24, he said that the Criteria-wise revised portal format has been allocated to the respective criteria coordinators and he asserted that criterion –wise finalization of criteria will be done between 6th Oct and 14th Oct.2024 and IQAC intends to undertake the common reading of AQAR in Nov.2024.

1.8 Autonomous status and Implementation of NEP 2020 (3.0)

Proposed by: Prof. Dr. A.K. Patil

Proposal: He highlighted on the availing of Autonomy from June 2019 and asserted that the year 2024-25 is the third year of Autonomy in the second cycle i.e. 6th year. He said that NEP (1.0) is implemented from 2022-23 as per Shivaji University, Kolhapur notifications. NEP 2020 (2.0) is also implemented from 2023-24 in all the Autonomous colleges in Maharashtra as per Government of Maharashtra resolutions issued on 20th April 2023. In this year, the Shivaji University has resolved to implement NEP 2020 (3.0)

IQAC views: He told the house that the four Deans of Faculty have prepared Credit Framework and the syllabi for first year UG & PG have been framed by sub Committees and BoS of respective departments.
