Proceedings of the Second Meeting of IQAC 2025-26 held on 26/11/2025

4.1 Confirmation of the proceedings of the Last Meeting:

Proposed by: Prof. Dr. G.B. Kalyanshetti

He read out the minutes of the Fourth IQAC meeting for the year 2025-26 held on 25th August 2025. He elaborated on following issues of Agenda considered therein such as confirmation of the proceedings of the First meeting, NAAC Revised Accreditation Process, review of Admissions, Examinations, Examinations Calendar 2025-26 & Handbook, Academic Calendar 2025-26, Library Booklet, Preparation of AQAR 2024-25, Workshop on IPR 2025-2026, Implementation of Autonomy & NEP 2025-26, New Academic Programs started from 2025-26 and IQAC Plan 2025-26.

He told the house that all the resolutions made in the last meeting have been complied with by undertaking necessary steps.

He requested all the members to approve of it.

All the members approved the proceedings of the third IQAC meeting.

The same is approved and resolved.

1.2 NAAC Revised Accreditation Process

Proposed by: Prof. Dr. G.B. Kalyanshetti

He presented the next issue of the NAAC Revised Accreditation process. He expressed that NAAC has initiated Reforms in January 2024 and told to the members that our college has become eligible from 1st July 2024 in revised framework. As per NAAC announcement, he further said, HEIs with valid accreditation as per old RAF whose validity is expiring between 1st July 2024 and the date of launch of MBGL shall be extended for 3 months after the launch of MBGL. He explained that in upcoming reforms, there are Two levels of Accreditation namely Binary & Maturity Based graded Level, manuals for which is awaited. He further said that he attended NAAC Workshop on A & A reforms on 19th March 2024 in which NAAC gave guidelines regarding 10 new Metrics. He said that NAAC will focus on Input, Process & Outcomes involving 63 Key indicators. NAAC in its revamped process would focus on **Impact** covering Curriculum Design, Faculty, Infrastructure and Finance. In **Process**, Learning & Teaching, Extended Curricular Engagements and Governance and Administration will be considered. Under **Outcomes**, Students' outcomes, Research & Innovation and Sustainability aspects will be covered. He further said that Executive Committee of NAAC Hon. Dr. Anil Shahastrabuddhe had been recently at SPPU Convocation Address on 29th September 2025 as a Chief Guest. According to him, about 82% HEIs across India have not been not accredited by NAAC and only 400 universities are accredited by this time. Dr. Sahastrabuddhe said that revised Accreditation framework will be published in about 2/3 months and old methodology will be replaced with the Launch of Basic Accreditation Framework. Then IQAC Coordinator elaborated on the revamped process stating that earlier Accreditation was for a five-year period and the revamped process will be of just three years. "The basic process of accreditation will be fully online with no field visits. He said that this is a major step in simplifying the process. After the basic accreditation, a new system of gradation will be introduced by NAAC signaling Maturity-Based Graded Accreditation with five levels: Level 1 and Level 5. Colleges and universities will upgrade one level after another. Level-1 and Level-2 are relatively easy & carried online. Level-3 will be a hybrid one with online and field visits. Institutions which already offer a high standard can directly apply to a higher level rather than approach the process step by step. Level-4 and Level-5 will be extremely difficult to obtain and have stringent qualifying criteria. Only be awarded to institutions offering education on par with international standards.

To this, the Chairperson Dr. Mohan Rajmane asked the Coordinator to start the preparation for Basic Accreditation once the guidelines will be announced and about the MBGL, he asserted, the decision will be taken.

He requested the members to approve of the issue.

2.3 IQAC work Done so far.....

He presented the issue of IQAC work done so far in the pretext of NAAC revised A & A process. He said that all the AQARs for the last five years have been submitted to NAAC. He elaborated on various Meetings of the criteria Coordinators between 11th Feb 2025 and 18th Feb 2025. He said that Data incorporation as per 10 criteria is ongoing as per the revised framework. IQAC has also organized review meeting on NAAC 4th cycle preparation First Review Meeting on 6th October, 2025.

He requested all the members to approve of the issue.
