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01. ABOUT THE RAYAT SHIKSHAN SANSTHA :

Late Padmabhushan Dr. Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil alias Anna established the Rayat Shikshan Sanstha at Kale, Tal. Karad, Dist. Satara on 4th October 1919 for imparting education to all and sundry, with the promise of self-help, self-culture, self-knowledge irrespective of caste, creed, colour or community. It is this secular aspect of the institution that is derived from the Father of the Nation who christened the first Boarding at Satara as the "Chhatrapati Shahu Boarding" in 1927. The Rayat Shikshan Sanstha is not only the institution of academic excellence but also a laboratory of social transformation. Karmaveer Anna believed in the principle that education is an instrument of social change. He started more than 500 voluntary schools all over Maharashtra without any financial aid from the Government. The 'Dignity of Labour' is the supreme value practised in the institution through its motto 'Education through self-help'. The emblem of the Sanstha is the banyan tree having several branches. Sanstha has completed 100 years of its establishment. Now a days, the sanstha runs 36 pre-primary schools, 51 primary schools, 438 secondary schools, 42 colleges, 7 training college, 90 hostels, 8 ashramshalas, 6 industrial training institutes, 5 regional offices and 59 other branches having 4,52,868 students and 12,965 employees. Five colleges of sanstha have got the Autonomous status. Six colleges were accredited 'A+' grade and twelve colleges were accredited 'A' grade by NAAC. Sanstha has made no. of MOUs with national & international institutes for quality education.

'श्रमाला महत्त्व' या न्यायाने त्यांनी संस्थेचे बोध वाक्य 'स्वावलंबी शिक्षण हेच आमचे ब्रीद' असे ठेवले. संस्थेचे बोधचिन्ह 'वटवृक्ष' असून त्यांच्या पारंब्याप्रमाणे संस्थेच्या शाखा सर्व महाराष्ट्रभर पसरलेल्या आहेत. संस्थेच्या ३६ पूर्व प्राथमिक शाळा, ५१ प्राथमिक शाळा, ४३८ माध्यमिक शाळा, ४२ महाविद्यालये, ७ ट्रेनिंग शाळा, ९० वसतिगृहे, ८ आश्रमशाळा, ६ इंडस्ट्रीयल ट्रेनिंग इन्स्टीट्यूट, ५ विभागीय कार्यालये आणि ५९ इतर शाखा कार्यरत आहेत. संस्थेमध्ये ४,५२,८६८ विद्यार्थी व १२९६५ शिक्षक/सेवक काम करत आहेत. संस्थेच्या पाच महाविद्यालयांना यु.जी.सी. ने स्वायत्ततेचा दर्जा बहाल केला आहे. ६ कॉलेजसना 'A+' ग्रेड तर १२ कॉलेजसना 'A' ग्रेड मिळाली आहे. शैक्षणिक गुणवत्ता वाढीसाठी संस्थेने राष्ट्रीय व आंतरराष्ट्रीय पातळीवरील विविध संस्थांशी सहकार्य करार केले आहेत.

02. ABOUT THE COLLEGE :

Established in June 1954, Sadguru Gadage Maharaj College, Karad, an affiliate of Shivaji University, Kolhapur, is a multi-faculty premier institute of higher education, having more than 12,000 students on its rolls. The college campus is spread over 17 acres of area in Vidyanagar, Karad. The late Karmveer Bhaurao Patil started this college by the confluence of the Krishna and the Koyana rivers. The college is recognised by the University Grants Commission under Section 2F and 12 (B) of U.G.C. Act and Accredited "A+" with CGPA 3.63 by NAAC, Bangalore. Besides, it is an ISO 9001 : 2015 Certified college from June 2019 gets an academic autonomous status by UGC. Although college is autonomous, the degree is awarded by the Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The college offers undergraduate & Post-graduate courses in disciplines of Arts, Commerce & Science. The college also offers professional, vocational diploma courses. There is also provision of a research degree i.e. M.Phil. and Ph.D. Our college has a study centre of Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University, Nashik. Our college is a renowned centre of various society - oriented activities. Special efforts are being made for the enrichment of 'Student - Teacher Research Cell', 'Gender Sensitization' and 'Women Empowerment.'

The college has a vibrant culture and a holistic approach to education. The simultaneous development of the intellectual, physical, cultural and emotional faculties of the students is achieved through various academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities such as Sports, NCC, NSS, and Art Circle. The college has been named after Gadage Maharaj, the sensitive, activist, philosopher and justice loving saint of Maharashtra.

This college has flourished under the able leadership of three former Vice Chancellors : Prin. Barr. P. G. Patil, Prin. R. K. Kanbarkar and Prin. Dr. V. K. Ghate, along with the Ex. Chairman of Maharashtra Public Service Commission, Prin. Mrs. S. P. Patil, the eminent educationist, Prin. A. B. Magdum and many other academicians. At present, Prin. Dr. Mohan Rajmane is shouldering the responsibility as the head of the institution.

From the year June 2019 the Dual Degree programme is introduced by which students are able to do two courses at a time and become self reliant.

ह्या कॉलेजमध्ये कला, वाणिज्य व विज्ञान विभाग पदवी व पदव्युत्तर स्तरावर शिकवले जातात. कॉलेजमध्ये यशवंतराव चव्हाण मुक्त विद्यापीठ, नाशिक यांचे केंद्र कार्यन्वित आहे. कॉलेजमध्ये समृद्ध असे ग्रंथालय, अभ्यासिका, प्रशस्त प्रयोगशाळा, इंटरनेट सेंटर, मुला-मुलींसाठी वसतिगृहे आहेत. कॉलेजमध्ये NSS, NCC, स्पर्धा परिक्षा मार्गदर्शन केंद्र आहे. हॉटेल मॅनेजमेंट, ब्युटीपार्लर यासारखे व्यवसायाभिमुख अनेक कोर्सेस कॉलेजमध्ये चालवले जातात. 'कमवा व शिका' या योजनेतून गरजू विद्यार्थ्यांना शिक्षणाची सोय उपलब्ध आहे.

जून २०१९ पासून प्रवेश घेतलेल्या विद्यार्थ्यांना एकाच वेळी दोन कोर्स (Dual Course) करण्याची संधी उपलब्ध झाली आहे. पदवी कोर्स सोबतच व्यवसायाभिमुख कोर्स विद्यार्थ्यांना करता येणार आहे. हा व्यवसायभिमुख कोर्स तीन स्तरावरती (सर्टिफिकेट, डिप्लोमा, अँडव्हान्स डिप्लोमा) पूर्ण करता येणार आहे. यामुळे विद्यार्थ्यांना रोजगार सक्षम होण्यास मदत होईल.

07. NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY :

Highlighting the importance of flexible learning, National Education Policy 2020 states that imaginative and flexible curricular structures will enable creative combinations of disciplines for study and would offer multiple entry and multiple exit (MEME) options and thus, remove the currently prevalent rigid boundaries. These would create new opportunities for students to choose and learn the subject(s) of their choice. While changing the HEI as per their preference, convenience or necessity. In order to pave the way for seamless student mobility, the NEP 2020 envisages adjustments in the structures and lengths of degree programmes. Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ensures seamless student mobility between or within degree-granting HEIs through a formal system of credit recognition, credit accumulation, credit transfers, and credit redemption to promote distributed and flexible teaching-learning. To take this forward, NEP 2020 promotes rigorous research-based specializations and opportunities for multidisciplinary education, at the Graduate, Master's and Doctoral level programmes in HEIs.

To reach to the design of holistic and multidisciplinary programmes as anticipated in NEP 2020, HEIs require some time to streamline it in higher education in India. As stated above, as per their university's/college's) preference, convenience or necessity, ideal multidisciplinary programmes may come into existence in future. However, existing undergraduate programmes may be converted into a new framework having multiple entry and multiple exit options and with additions of Skill Enhancement Courses in credit system. The continuous comprehensive evaluation is also a requirement for proper mapping of learning outcomes, course outcomes and programme outcomes as our system is based on principles of outcome based education. Hence, the university will continue its choice based credit system for quality-based evaluation programmes.

In the light of NEP 2020, HEI can provide the courses as per tune preference, convenience or necessity for the students.

1) Title :

The Regulations Governing the Choice Based Credit System with Multiple Entry and multiple Exit Option.

2) Scope :

These regulations are applicable to the undergraduate and postgraduate degree programmes being offered in affiliated colleges/institutes, Excluding autonomus colleges / instituted and in university departments.

3) Commencement :

These Regulations in accordance with National Education Policy 2020 shall come from Academic Year 2022-23 onwards. These regulations shall be implemented from academic year.

4) NEP Implementation in First Phase :

The credit and curricular framework is to be made applicable, in the first phase, to the following programmes (other than those regulated by AICTE, PCI, BCI, CoA, NCTE etc.) with effect from Academic year 2023-24 :

UG: B.A., B.Sc., B.Com. and all Non-AICTE Professional UG Degree Programs.

PG: M.A., M.Sc., M.Com. and all Non-AICTE Professional PG Degree Programs.

5. Credit Framework under Three / Four Years UG Programmes with Multiple Entry and Multiple Exit options :

The structure of the Three / Four year bachelor's degree programme allows the opportunity to the students to experience the full range of holistic and multidisciplinary education in addition to a focus on the chosen major and minors as per their choices and the feasibility of exploring learning in different institutions. The minimum and maximum credit structure for different levels under the Three / Four year UG Programme with multiple entry and multiple exit options are as given below :

08. DUAL PROGRAMME :

In the pretext of academic autonomy, the college introduces Dual Programme from June 2019.

The students admitted in the first year U.G. programme will be offered a range of skill oriented and capacity enhancement courses stream wise from which a student must choose one course from it. A student will be completing three courses successively in his/her graduating years namely Certificate, Diploma and Advanced Diploma. The classes of the same will be conducted after their formal academic work. These courses enhance students' employability. Students completing the graduation will be enriched with three additional certification under this 'Dual Programme'.

15. EXAMINATION PATTERN :

The Students should note that 75% attendance is compulsory for theory and practical to become eligible for appearing at the examination.

College will conduct Internal / Term end examinations as per norms laid down by Shivaji University, Kolhapur. There is semester pattern for all classes. Whereas practical exam is conducted annually.

Our college has been conferred upon Autonomous status from academic year 2019-20 by U.G.C. In the pretext of the same, the college has formed the Board of Examination and Evaluation as per the guidelines of UGC and Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The board introduce reforms in the evaluation pattern for the first year of UG & PG programmes.

In the credit based semester system under continuous evaluation there will be an internal evaluation and semester end evaluation.

Internal Examination incorporated to bring an optimum involvement of students to excel their academic performance. It comprises various measures such as Home Assignment, Class Tests, Oral Examination Online Examination etc.

16. DISCIPLINE AND CODE OF CONDUCT :

16.1 Discipline :

i) Self - discipline is the best discipline. All the students are expected to

observe rules and regulations currently in force to enable smooth working of the college.

17. WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING :

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- a) Any conduct by any student whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- b) Indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- c) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- d) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- f) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it : sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- h) Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.

18. STUDENTS' COUNCIL :

- viii. Two lady students nominated by the Principal. The student members of the council shall elect, from among themselves, the Secretary of the Council.
 - The Students' Council is generally formed on 30th July every year. After the official formation, the names and other information of the Students' Council members are sent to Shivaji University, Kolhapur.
 - The election to the post of 'Secretary' of the College Students' Council is held on the date fixed by the Vice-Chancellor as per the relevant statute of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994.

19. LIBRARY FACILITIES :

The Keshavrao Pawar Central Library of the college was established in the year 1954, since then library has made consistent progress in terms of collection of books, periodicals, e-resources and services. The college has very enriched in terms of availability of reference books and text books. The library has total 145157 books, 97 Print (National and International) Journals, and 9 News Papers, 839 CDs/DVDs, 120 Cassests. The library is having active membership of INTERNET N-LIST E Resource Consortia and Provides 6000+ E-Journals and 3135000+ E-books on various subjects.

19.1 General Rules :

- i) Every student must have a valid college Identity Card in the premises of the library. It should be produced as and when demanded by any of the Library staff.
- ii) Identity Card and Borrower's Card are non-transferable.
- iii) Students must handle the books or periodicals etc. with great care. Any attempt to damage books or periodicals by defacing them or tearing the pages off, shall be treated as misconduct and be strictly dealt with.
- iv) If the original identity-card is lost, a duplicate I-Card will be issued on payment of Rs. 25/- only.

19.2 Rules For The Study-room :

- i) Complete silence and strict discipline be maintained in the library and study-room.
- ii) Text books, Reference books, University Question papers and Journals will be issued to students against I-cards. Students are not allowed to take them outside the study-room.
- iii) If any particular reference is required, students should approach the Librarian.

19.3 Home-issue:

- a. Every student is expected to read and strictly follow the Instructions given on the reverse side of the Borrower's Card.
- b. In case of the late return of books, students will have to pay a fine of .50 paise per day for the first week and Rs.1/- per day afterwards. In case of serious default, the amount of fine may be increased upto Rs.5/-per day.
- c. While charging the fine, holidays will be counted.
- d. Re-issue of the books will depend upon the demand for the same.
- e. Any disregard to these rules will be reported to the Principal for appropriate action.

19.4 Book Bank:

The college has a Book-Bank facility for needy students. Interested students may contact to the Librarian for membership of Book-Bank Scheme.

19.5 Scholar's Card:

To promote excellence, scholar's cards are issued to top 10 students from each class. These cards facilitate the students to borrow an additional book for home reading (i.e. Two books instead of one). If a student has any difficulty he may contact the Librarian.
