Report of the Functioning of Autonomous College 2020-21

It is a pleasure for me to present the report of the functioning of an Autonomous college from June 2020 to the UGC- WRO, Pune.

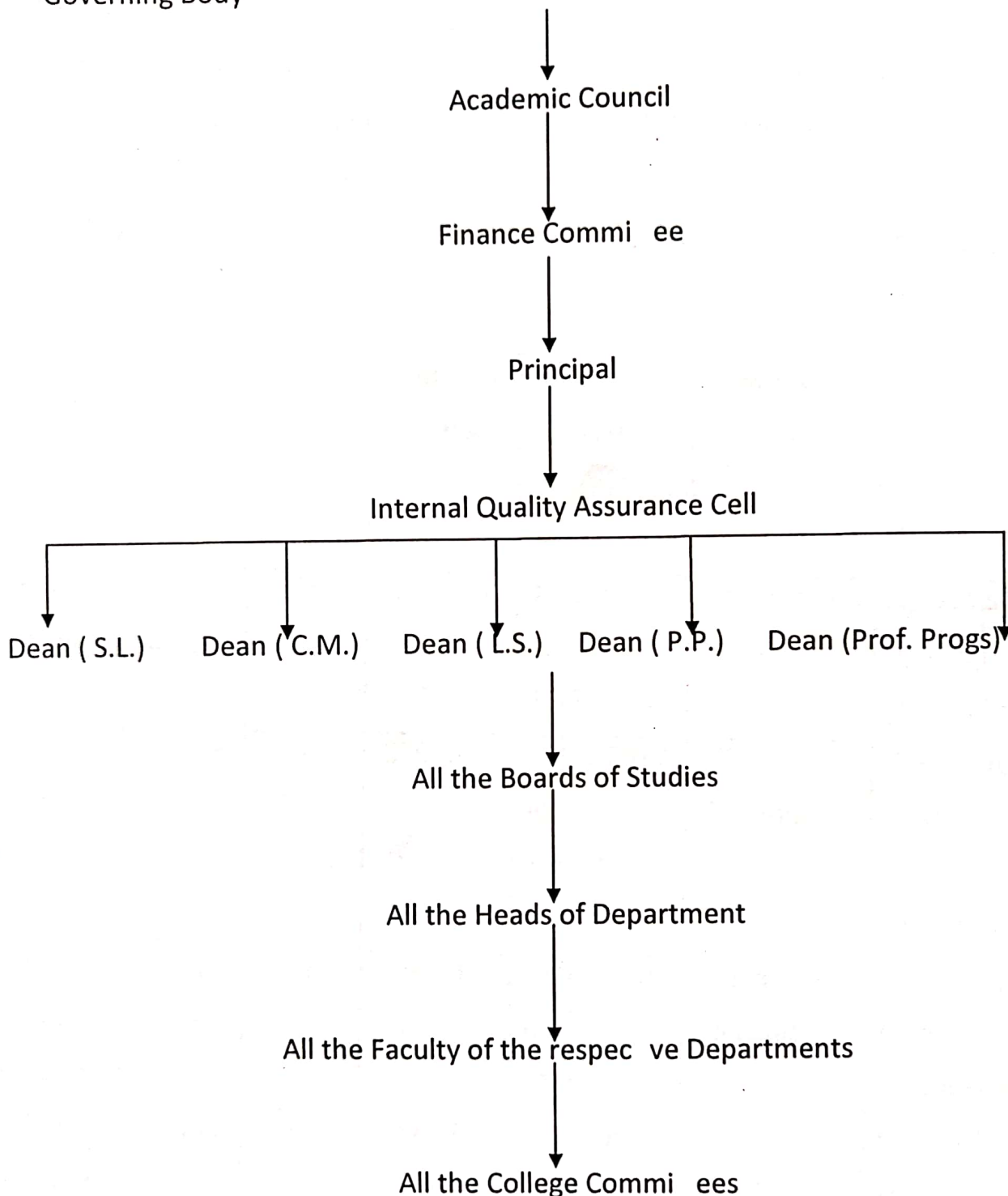
First of all, I extend my sense of thankfulness towards UGC, New Delhi for conferring upon us an autonomous status to our college from June 2019 for the period of ten years. As per the directives issued by UGC, New Delhi, Govt. of Maharashtra and Shivaji University, Kolhapur, the college has initiated the functioning of an autonomous college from June 2019.

Following are the activities we have carried out during the academic year 2020-21.

- 1) The college received the Fresh Autonomous status from UGC through its letter No.F22-1/2017 (AC) dated 28 Dec.2018.
- 2) It has also received the Conferment of Fresh Autonomous status from Shivaji University, Kolhapur through its letter No.SU/A ./T-2/ Autonomy/1907 dtd. 20/2/2019.
- 3) In purview of the autonomous status, the college has defined policies for curricula revision, redefining teaching methodologies, Evaluation pattern and the preparation of study material and Question Bank.
- 4) The college has adopted School concept and channelized 4 schools respective to streams and carried out its academic, research and extension activities.

5) The administrative structure of the Autonomous college has been functioning as follows.

6) The college has constituted all the Statutory and Non-Statutory committees such as Boards of Studies in 22 disciplines, Academic Council, Finance Committee and Governing Body and other committees as per UGC Regulations 2018 which are

displayed on the college website www.sgm.edu.in. meetings of which have conducted and the minutes of the same are displayed on the college website.

7) Rashtriya Uchhatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA):

The college is a RUSA beneficiary of Component 8. After the official sanction of the project, IQAC conducted the meeting with all the Heads of the Departments and RUSA Coordinator and conducted some of the activities approved by RUSA. 8) The college has prepared the Budget for 2020-21 and the same is discussed and rec ed in the presence of Shri. V.T. Pa l, Finance O cer, Shivaji University, Kolhapur in the Finance Commi ee mee ng held on 6th October 2020 and the approved Budget is submi ed to UGC-WRO, PUNE. The college s ll awaits the release of the Autonomous college Grant from WRO-UGC, Pune.

9)The mee ngs of all the statutory bodies such as Boards of Studies, Finance Commi ee, Academic Council, Governing Body and Board of Exams have been organized and the proceedings of the same are displayed on the college website www.sgm.edu.in.

10)There are 24 Boards of Studies that have conducted the mee ngs of Sub-Commi ee and Boards of Studies in which the curricula and Evalua on pa ern for the Second year UG& PG classes have been revised following a systema c process.

11) The college has adopted 60 Marks (Semester End Exam) and 40 Marks (Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation) pattern.

12) The Examination committee has defined various measures of evaluation such as Online MCQ, Assignment, test, oral etc from which the department has a freedom to opt 4 for 40 Marks CCE.

13) The college has adopted Choice Based Credit system for the first year UG and PG programmes which will sustain for a year and the next two years respectively.

14) A few Departments have organized Workshops on Revised Curricula in the months of October, November 2020.

15) The First meetings of the Statutory Bodies such as Governing Body, Academic Council, and Finance Committee have been organized and the proceedings of the same are displayed on the college website.

16) The college has successfully conducted Entrance Exam for the admissions to the P.G. in 9 Science Subjects at 4 Centres in the month of September/ October 2020.

17) The First Semester end Examination of the first year and Third Second year U.G. & P.G. programmes were conducted online between

18) The college has purchased Software from Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil College of Engineering, Satara for Admission and examinations.

19) The 24 Dept. have organised Webinars in their respective discipline from June to September 2020 in the wake of COVID-19.

20) The college has adopted a Dual Programme under Autonomy for the first year U.G. & P.G. Classes. Due to COVID-19 pandemic, we could not run the Certificate & Diploma courses under Dual programme.

21) For effective online teaching, the college has installed 3 Lecture Capturing Systems through which more than 600 lectures were captured and are uploaded on college website and Youtube. The college has purchased 1 Smart Board, 1 Video Conferencing Unit, 10 LCDs, 15 Scanner with Printer and 150 computers and Laptops.

22) The 100 % of its faculty engaged their classes through ICT resources. The soft copy of e resources is maintained in the Library.

23) The college has organized 2 Internal Webinars.

24) The college through IQAC has constituted the **The External Peer Team** for the Review of the performance of the college as an Autonomous college through its appointment letters No 1928/19-20 dated 6-12-2019. The team comprised of Dr. C.J. Khilare, Principal, (Chairman), Balwant College, Vita, Dr. Dr.S.B.Kengar, (Member), Principal, Yashwantrao Chavan College of Science, Karad and Dr.G.V.Mali, (Member), IQAC Coordinator, Smt. Bayabai Shripatrao Kadam Kanyamahavidyalay, Kadegaon. The committee visited the college on 19th January 2021 to review the performance of the college made so far as an Autonomous college. They inspected related documents in the context of autonomy between 11.00 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on the campus and submitted the report to IQAC, the copy of which is sent to UGC-WRO, Pune.

25) **Online Teaching**

In the wake of COVID 19, the college has internalized Online teaching for the students of UG and PG classes. The college has purchased 5 zoom subscriptions. The Time table for online teaching delivery was prepared and the faculty started addressing students online from July 2020 and the same is being continued in the months of March, April & May 2021. The college has installed 3 studios for lecture capturing through which more than 700 lectures have been captured and the same were uploaded on the Departmental Channel of respective subjects on www.sgm.edu.in and Youtube. The e-resources have been maintained in the library.

26) **Organisation of Workshop on IPR**

As per the resolution passed in the first meeting of IQAC held in June 2020, a workshop on Intellectual Property Rights was organized on 18th February 2021. The Key note Address was delivered by Mr. Kishore Ingale, a Member of IPR team of TCS, Pune. He discussed in detail about the topics like 'What is copyright?' 'What do we mean by author or creator?' He highlighted on various forms of IPR like patents, Trademarks, Copyright which is related to books, literature, Performing Arts software codes etc. He also elaborated on the precautions to be taken by the researchers while writing research papers.

27) **Academic Programs from 2021-22**

The college intends to initiate a programme of B.Sc. in Agriculture under B.Voc, specialisation of Industrial Management at B.Com Part III, B.Com in Business Management from June 2021. The college also intends to start additional Divisions for M.Sc. Statistics, Microbiology, Organic Chemistry, Analytical Chemistry and a Certificate course in Yoga Therapy and meditation. The proposals in the prescribed format have

been submitted to the Shivaji University and the Local Inquiry Committee has of Shivaji University has visited the college on 13th March 2021 and scrutinized all the related documents for proposed B.Com in Bank Management & Specialization of Industrial Management at B.Com III.

28) UGC-PARAMARSHA

Under UGC PARAMARSHA scheme 2019-20, the college has organized a National level Workshop on Agro-business opportunities in Biosciences from 1st February 2021 to 5th February 2021 in collaboration with the mentee college Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Retahre, BK.

29) IQAC

1. IQAC conducted Online meeting with the IQAC members and other Faculty members using zoom platform on 22nd April 2020.
2. IQAC conducted Online Webinar on Smart Tools for Teaching and Research using Zoom platform on 24th April 2020 in collaboration with Keshavrao Pawar Library, SGM college Karad. Shri. Arjun Jadhav from Mumbai was the Key speaker.
3. IQAC also conducted Online meeting with the Principals and IQAC Coordinators of mentee colleges using Zoom platform. Dr. Pramod Pabrikar from RUSA, Mumbai and Dr. Mohan Rajmane were the Guest Speakers at the Online Webinar conducted on 9th May 2020 during COVID 19 Lockdown period.
4. Organised a workshop on Intellectual Property Rights on 18th Feb 2021 in which Mr. Kishore Ingle, Member, IPR Team, Tata Consultancy Services, Pune
5. Organised 24 National/State level webinars on urgent issues in collaboration with 24 departments respectively
6. Organized a National level Workshop on Agro-business opportunities in Biosciences from 1st February 2021 to 5th February 2021 in collaboration with the Mentee college Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Retahre, BK.
