One day workshop on B.Sc. I syllabus under autonomous status was organized by the Department of Botany and Plant Protection on Thursday, 25/07/2019 at 11am onwards in the Department. For this workshop two resource persons were invited, Dr. (Mrs.) V. C. Karande, Head Department of Botany, YashwantraoChavan Institute of Science, Satara and Dr. G.G.
