

Memorandum of understanding

This memorandum of understanding (MoU) is made on January 2021

By and Between

TechSid Software Solution, Jadhav Sanul, Flat no. 7, Sidapur Rd, Yashavant Colony, Vidyanagar, Karad

And

Sadguru Gadage Maharaj College Karad having its registered office at Karad. (Hereinafter referred to as "**SGM, Karad**" which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning there of be deemed to mean and include its trustees, successors and permitted assigns) of the other part.

(Both hereinafter referred to individually as "Institute" or organization)

Whereas, "**TechSid Software Solution, Karad**" and "**SSGM, Karad**" propose to sign Memorandum of understanding for -

1. Staff Exchange Programs
2. Training (technical & Non-technical)
3. Placement Assistance
4. Workshop, Events & Activities etc
5. Providing Guest Lectures

To establish a **Center of Excellence** to build a strong bond with each other and facilitate initiation of mutually beneficial activities in the field of academic, Technical, Managerial and Social Knowledge Sharing, optimization of resources, educational enhancement, expertise augmentation and become a role model for any Inter Institutional & Industries- Institutes Integration.

Now, Both the parties agrees as follows:

OBJECTIVE:

To involve “TechSid Software Solution, Karad” and “SGM, Karad” to achieve academic excellence and to engage in the following activities:

1. Staff exchange program:

- a) To share practical knowledge in the field of IT, HR, Finance, Operations, Marketing and other fields of Management.
- b) To design and arrange Management Development Program (MDP), Faculty Development Program (FDP) and Staff Development Program (SDP) on latest trends and demands of Industries.

2. Resource sharing:

- a) To share facility and infrastructure for multiple events such as Seminar, Workshops etc.
- b) To make available Library arena Computer Labs, Seminar Hall, Sport ground to conduct training programs for students and or faculties

3. Student exchange program:

- a) To organize Industrial visit for the students,
- b) To arrange for Placement drives & Internship opportunities for students,
- c) To support students for product Research and Project Development.
- d) To extend invitation for sessions of eminent speakers from industries and expert members from the institute.

4. Other collaborations:

- a) To jointly promote Corporate Social Responsibility
- b) To collaborate for multi-disciplinary research, consultancy and Projects.
- c) To encourage faculty members and students to participate in high end programs like National International Conferences, seminars FDP’s, Workshops.

5. Any other initiative, activity or program not specified above to be mutually discussed and agreed upon after due approvals.

ACTION PLAN:

- a) Each origination shall designate a liaison officer to develop and coordinate the specification activities agreed upon.
- b) At the time of any joint exercise, the participant will be issued a certificate of merit signed by both organizations.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is only to express the intentions of the Institutes and is not interred to be legally bound on either party
- 2. The terms of cooperation of each specific activity completed under this Memorandum of Understanding including costs involved shall be multi discussed and agreed upon in writing by both Instates prior to the initiation of that activity,
- 3. This Memorandum of Understanding imposes no financial obligations on either party
- 4. Each party recognizes that the other party has, may have or will have arrangements of a similar or different nature with other institutions.
- 5. Each party shall keep confidential any information that it receives from the other party. Publication of any material that is jointly developed by the two Institutes will be considered as confidential and will not be shared in any public forum or with any third party, without prior consent/approval of the other in writing, obtained from the authorized signatory.
- 6. This memorandum shall remain in effect for the period of FIVE year from the date of its execution by both Institutes. Either Party may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding by giving seven days notice in writing to the other Party.
- 7. The terms of cooperation may be extended beyond the terms mentioned in this Memorandum of Understanding, on the basis of discussion and upon mutual agreement between the two Institutes

MISCELLANEOUS:

a) Invalidity:

If any provision of this MOU, or any portion thereof, is held to be invalid or unenforceable under any applicable statute or rule of law, then that provision or portion notwithstanding, this MOU will remain in full force and effect and such provision or portion will be deemed omitted and this MOU will be construed as if such invalid or unenforceable provision or portion had not been contained herein.

b) No Waiver:

No term or provisions hereof will be considered waived by either party, and no breach excused by either party, unless such waiver or consent is in writing, signed on behalf of the party against whom the waiver is asserted. No consent by either party to, or waiver of, a breach by either party, whether express or implied, will constitute consent to, waiver of, or excuse of any other, different, or subsequent breach by either party.

c) Entire Agreement:

This MOU states the entire understanding between the Institutes on this subject and supersedes all prior negotiations, understandings, and agreements between the Institutes concerning the subject matter. No amendment or modification of this MOU shall be made except by a writing signed by both organizations.

d) Independent Contractors:

This MOU shall not constitute, create, give effect to, or otherwise recognize a joint venture, partnership, or formal business organization of any kind. Neither Party shall have the authority to bind the other without the prior written approval of the other in each and every case other than as specifically provided for in this MOU.

e) Publicity:

Neither Party shall make any public announcements in connection with this MoU without the prior written approval of the other Party.

f) Force Majeure:

Neither Party shall be liable to the other for failing perform its obligations under this MOU because of circumstances beyond control. Circumstances shall include, but not be limited to, any acts or omissions of any government or governmental authority, natural disaster, act of a public enemy, acts of

terrorism, riot, sabotage, disputes or differences with workmen, power failure, delays in transportation or deliveries of supplies or materials, acts of God, computer hardware, software and telecommunications failure or any events reasonably beyond the control of such Party.

g) Dispute Resolution:

Any disputes or differences with respect to or in relation with this MoU shall be settled by mutual discussions of the Institutes within a period of thirty (30) days. In case Institutes fail to amicably settle the disputes or differences within the aforesaid period, this MoU shall stand terminated.
